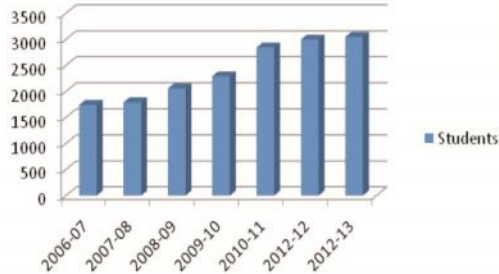

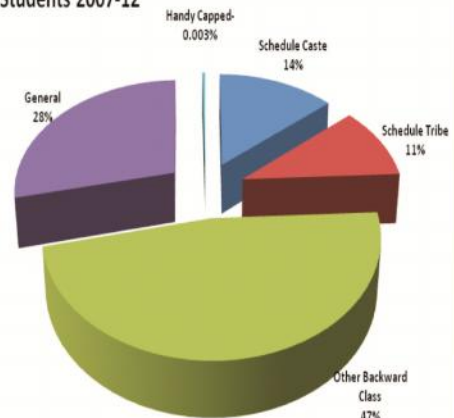

Students Profile In Last Years

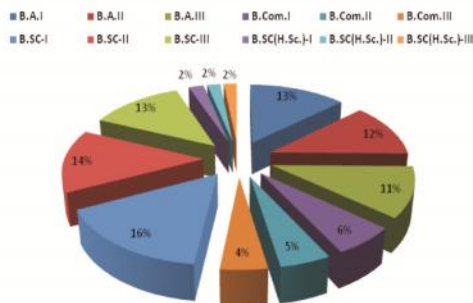
Students Growth In Last seven years



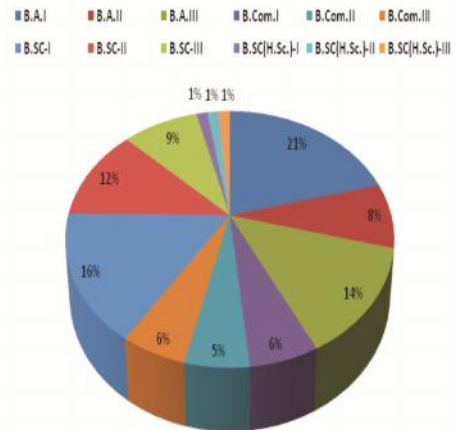
Total Students 2007-12
