Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is one of the mandatory criteria set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It is also a pre qualifier for Assessment and Accreditation of the institution. From 2019 onwards the NAAC has endeavored to conduct a Student Experience Survey, the results of which will go into the accreditation process. The Survey includes 20 competency based questions, responses to which are given anonymously by students of the institution. This survey corresponds to an institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experience.

### 2. Survey Methodology-



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




